If the need arises, a man with lesser abilities will be put into the women's side, and if necessary to equalize team numbers, a top female darter (hopefully voluntarily) will be placed into the men's side. If there are still more of one gender than the other, then the drawing will first be of the gender with the fewest players, and then all other names will be drawn.
