AT THE PLAYOFF:

Write an official report of any/all disturbances.

1. - CHECK THAT EACH PLAYER IS A MEMBER OF THE ADO, either as a representative of an ADO Affiliated Member Organization OR as an ADO Individual Member.

Should you have ANY questions, contact your Area Manager for clarification. Ten (10) copies of the ADO Playoff Rules & Regulations have been provided for your convenience.

- Current membership lists are included for your convenience. ADO Individual Members MUST play in the region in which they registered their ADO Membership. Foreign players must register with the ADO office and be able to prove they have been continuously domiciled in the US for a minimum of three years without representing another country (i.e. green card/passport valid for more than six months plus employment/rental record). Regional fees may be paid with check, money order or credit card.
- All Regional finalists MUST COMPLETE a Regional Registration Form before beginning Regional competition. Regional Playoff Format will be Round Robin 501 SS/DO, 3 straight legs, 1 point per leg.
- ALL decisions regarding the NUMBER of advancing qualifiers MUST BE MADE **BEFORE** THE START OF PLAY. The top 2 of each initial round-robin advance to a round robin that will determine who are national finalists and who are the alternates.
- 2. READ THE FOLLOWING SECTION TO THE PLAYERS BEFORE THE COMPETITION BEGINS; then keep handy for reference when necessary to maintain an orderly progression of play.
  - Good sportsmanship shall be the prevailing attitude throughout the tournament.
  - FAILURE TO COMPLETE AN ADO ROUND ROBIN PLAYOFF WILL RESULT IN DISCIPLINARY ACTION.

- Per ADO Tournament Rule #12, should a player fail to report to the assigned board within the 15 minute allotted time, a Forfeit will be called.
- **3. PLAY:** All groupings will be made by blind-draw.
  - **Play all brackets to completion.** Should a player/s fail to complete an ADO Round Robin playoff, all matches involving said player/s will be considered null and void.
  - ALL TIES IN THE FINAL ROUND ROBIN MUST BE BROKEN. (See Playoff Rules under TIEBREAKER).
  - Give the advancers the WINNER'S LETTER: Policy changes have been made in regards to **DRESS CODE** and **AIRLINE TICKETS.** The top page should be completed and signed by your regional winners and returned to you. The Alternates need to complete these forms as well.

## 4. – AFTER THE PLAYOFF:

- Pull the Registration sheet for each advancer and the alternates. Make sure their forms are complete and legible.
- Distribute REGIONAL FINALIST AWARDS & SPECIAL AWARD CERTIFICATES
- Get a money order for all cash received.
- Send one set of Regional Report forms to your Area Manager.
- Send all other Regional paperwork (<u>ALL</u> Registration Forms and round robin forms including tie-breakers) and ALL CHECKS/MONEY ORDERS <u>within 48 h</u> <u>ours</u> TO THE <u>ADO OFFICE</u> 230 N. Crescent Way Ste. K Anaheim, CA 92801
- **5. PHONE or FAX Playoff Results to the ADO Office IMMEDIATELY following your Playoff.** The Phone message tape (714 254-0212), Fax machine (714 254-0214), and e-mail: ADOdarts1@aol.com operate 24 hours. Be prepared to provide complete information as follows:
  - Region # and the number of Men's entries/Women's entries (or Combined)
  - Name, address, phone number, email if available, and the date & time of travel
  - requested, and shirt size for each advancer and alternate
  - Specify if your winner/s or alternate already has a ticket!
