



The opportunity to enjoy the holiday of a life time in one of the most sought after Caribbean island destinations in the world in the company of others who share the same love of darts!

The Festival caters for darts players of all standards, both male and female, and their family and friends who may wish to come along just as supporters to enjoy all that Barbados is justly famous for and to join in the varied list of optional excursions and activities.

The social darts events take place at a The Sporting Pig in St Lawrence Gap, a short walk from your hotel, and the major tournaments, with cash prizes, will be staged at the well appointed, air conditioned Solidarity House over the weekend of November 11 - 13. Participants will be transported to and from here by bus.

The Festival Director wants to ensure that it retains the character that has made it so popular – namely a Darts Festival that caters for all, rather than a darts tournament dominated by the few.

Your accommodation in the popular St Lawrence Gap is just yards away from, on one side, the clear, warm, azure blue ocean and, on the other, a host of restaurants, bars, night clubs, and shops – all within easy walking distance.

Hotel rooms to suit all tastes and budgets are available from \$95 US per night (an A/C room to include continental breakfast for two – that's \$47.50 US per person as they sleep two) and the fee for full participation in all the events at the Festival is \$120 US per person and \$60 per person as social members.

HOW TO JOIN US:

Simply organise your air travel to Barbados to take in the weekend of November 11 – 13 and to give yourself time to enjoy all that Barbados has to offer. Barbados is well served by regular direct flights from Toronto, New York and Miami.

Then make contact with The Festival Director Michael Heal and he will organise a hotel room to meet your requirements and budget.

Conditions for entry to the Festival are that participants must book their hotel accommodation through the Festival Director and pay a registration fee of \$120 US per person for full participation and \$60 US for social participation at least one month prior to the Festival. All matters relating to the organisation and participation in the Barbados Darts Festival remain at the discretion of The Festival Director.
