FORMAT: All rounds up to Semis are best of 5 (501 SS/DF, Cricket, Cricket, 501 SS/DF, Choice), Semis are best of 9 (501 SS/DF, Cricket, Cricket, 501, Cricket, 501 SS/DF, Cricket, Choice), Finals are best of 3, sets Best of 5 legs with alternating starts. Cork determines start of 1st leg. Winner of cork starts odd legs. If deciding game is necessary, players will cork. Deciding game is called and started by the winner of the cork. Group play (4 players/group) will commence 11/11/2016 at 10 am (M) and 10:30 am (L) with knockout round starting at 2 pm (M) and 2:30 pm (L).

The 64 men (32 ladies) in the Seacoast Dart Association's 1st New England Pro Chicago Event will be determined in the following manner. The first 30 men (14 ladies) will be chosen by the North America Professional Dart Alliance (NAPDA) Order of Merit (OoM) as of August 31, 2016. The NAPDA OoM will be posted on the Seacoast Open website as well as the Seacoast Open Facebook page. The Top 30 men (14 ladies) will have the 1st opportunity to register and be seeded in this event. They will have until October 2, 2016 to register and pay their \$75 (M), \$50 (L) entry fee. Any top 30 man (14 ladies) not registered by this date will be required to play in and win a qualifier in order to advance to the main event. On October 3, 2016, the registration will open to the remaining NAPDA OoM players. Payment and registration must be completed by October 23, 2016. On this date, the top 30 men (14 ladies) that have been received will be registered and seeded. All remaining players that attempted to register but were not in the top 30 (14) will have their choice of receiving a refund or applying their fee towards their qualifier. The 31st and 32nd seed (M), 15th and 16th seed (L) positions will be reserved for SDA via special qualifiers. This is to ensure local players may have the benefit of participating in the Pro event. The last 32 (M) and 16 (L) positions will be determined by group play round robin best of 5 format. The Group play is open to players not already seeded. Winners of group play are drawn into Main Event Knockout Bracket. Entry fee for group play is \$50 (M) and \$30 (L). If qualified, fee will be applied to the Main Event cost requiring an additional \$25 (M) and \$20 (L). Pre-registration is required for reserving your seeded position.
