Any open spots on February 8th will be filled by the next player in the rankings,

The last 32(0), 16(L) are determined by the 4 qualifiers, with the Top 8 (0), Top 4 (L) in each qualifier advancing and drawn into the bracket.

Qualifier fees: \$50 each(O),\$40(L), or all 4 for \$100(O),\$80(L). Qualifiers are best of 5.
