

ADO 2026 Ranking System

The new ADO Ranking System introduces a standardized ranking points system for ADO events, anchored to individual event payout. The system ensures fairness, scalability, and transparency by indexing ranking points to prize money.

Core Formula

For each singles event (Open & Women) where P=the payout of that singles event in USD:

- Winner (1): $P \times 0.10$
- Runner-up (2): $P \times 0.08$
- Semifinalists (4): $P \times 0.06$
- Quarterfinalists (8): $P \times 0.04$
- Rd-of-16 losers (16): $P \times 0.02$
- Rd-of-32 losers (32): $P \times 0.01$
- Rd-of-64 losers (64): $P \times 0.005$

Number of positions eligible for points

Event points limit

- Each player will only be able to count their 15 best points performances over the 52 week period toward their ranking.

National Qualifier points

- 75 points for winners/qualifiers
- 30 points for everyone else participating

Nationals points

- Nationals points will be awarded as a tournament based on a \$10,000 (Open) /\$5000 (Women) payout.
